Subject: USAID's response to Israeli's ground invasion in North Gaza

Status: Heightened

Event:

The Israeli-Palestine conflict has resulted in large amounts of casualties, and a disastrous humanitarian crisis in North Gaza. Since the Hamas attack on Israel on October 7th, 1.7 million Gazans have been displaced, and much of Gaza's infrastructure has been leveled. More than 234,000 homes have been damaged across Gaza and 46,000 have been destroyed, which is roughly 60% of the housing stock in the strip. Gazans are suffering from a lack of water, food, and cloths, which compounds human suffering. On November 24th a ceasefire entered into effect, giving outside Nations, and outside sources to provide humanitarian aid in Gaza.

Action:

By working with regional partners such as Egypt, and Saudi Arabia, the United States can simultaneously reactivate regional diplomatic relations, and help provide humanitarian aid for

the citizens of Gaza. The United States cannot enter Gaza itself, however the United States can provide food, medical equipment, and cloths to help save lives.

Estimated cost: 10 million
