

Israel: Israel is governed by a parliamentary system with a mostly ceremonial President, a Prime minister and a parliament. Its most pressing concern is security, a concern that has only gotten more important following the 2023 Hamas raid, which resulted in thousands of casualties and a two-year-long war. The Hamas raid shattered Israel's security and resulted in it becoming far more aggressive and proactive in dealing with threats to its security. Such as launching a pager attack and military intervention in Lebanon to neutralise Hezbollah. And a military intervention in Iran to eliminate its ability to make nuclear weapons. Despite the weakening of its enemies, it remains surrounded by enemies who have not been fully neutralised. So its chief security concerns are continuing to ensure that Hamas, Hezbollah, the Houthis and Iran can not threaten it. And to continue normalisation talks with Saudi Arabia and other Middle Eastern states as part of the Abraham Accords.
